The Cary Park District offers a summer of adventure, exploration, and creativity. Through summer day camp, children play, exercise, gain independence, learn life skills, make friends, and have a memorable summer. Our camp counselors provide a non-competitive environment for children to relax, have fun, and be themselves. Our camps are full of fun for all ages. Register your child in the grade level he or she is entering this fall.

Summer Camp Registration

Registrations will be processed daily at the Cary Park District Community Center. Faxed registrations may be sent to 847-639-6290. All registrations must be accompanied with payment. Payment options include cash, check, Visa, MasterCard or Cary Park District payment plan. Payment plans are available for those campers who are attending several camp sessions. Options include weekly credit card or prearranged withdrawal from your checking account (ACH). Full payment for the first session of camp must be received when enrolling in the payment plan option. A \$5 service fee will be added to each installment of weekly payments. If ACH is used, this service fee will be waived. Details and the forms for credit card or ACH payment options are available at the Community Center or www.carypark.com.

For proper staff to camper ratios, it is preferred that all camp and before & after camp registrations be received by 4:00 pm on the Friday prior to the start of a new session. Parent packets containing a parent manual, emergency cards, field trip information, discipline forms and swim levels will be available in May. This packet will be mailed, e-mailed, available for pick up at the Community Center, and can be downloaded from the camp section of our website at www.carypark.com.

Emergency cards will be included in the parent packets and **MUST BE RETURNED** before the first day of camp. Campers will not be admitted into camp unless completed emergency cards are on file at the camp's site. Emergency cards are available at the Community Center or online at www.carypark.com.

If you need to withdraw your child from camp, a withdrawal form must be completed and a \$5 service charge will be accessed for each camp session. After June 1, a \$5 processing fee will be accessed for each session transfer request. All cancellations or changes must be submitted in writing to the Cary Park District Community Center. Withdrawal forms are available at the Community Center or online at www.carypark.com.
