



# Camp ECHO & ECHO Extreme Camper Code of Conduct

As a camper, I promise to:

- Show respect to all campers and treat them as I would like to be treated.
- Show respect to Camp Staff and cooperate with their instructions.
- Not yell or scream inappropriate language at any campers or members of the Camp Staff.
- Communicate any problems or issues at camp with my Camp Counselor, Camp Coordinator or Assistant Camp Coordinator in an appropriate manner, which means I must not use foul language or gestures, harsh words or tone of voice.
- Respect the rights and beliefs of others, and treat others with courtesy and consideration.
- Conduct myself responsibly. I understand that horseplay, bullying, teasing or other unkind behaviors are not allowed.
- Not deliberately cause bodily harm to other campers or Camp Staff. I understand that pushing, kicking, biting, hitting, or fighting are not acceptable and will not be tolerated.
- Respect the property of Camp Staff, Campers, and the Camp Facility.
- Be responsible for my actions and understand that irresponsible behavior will result in disciplinary actions.
- Stay with my group at all times and ask permission to leave the group for any reason.

## Disciplinary Actions for Violations of the Code of Conduct

- Verbal Warning/Talk with Counselor and Camp Coordinator (3 Times/3 Strikes)
- Call to parents and put on a behavior contract
- Suspension from the program
- Termination from the program

**The Cary Park District staff reserves the right to suspend or expel any camper whose actions are seen as detrimental to the camp program. Each situation will be evaluated on its own merit. The camp staff may develop additional rules for each camp site as they deem necessary.**
