With that being said, in order to ensure compliance with current state and county orders and the health and safety of our campers and staff, we have implemented additional camp guidelines.

Campers must:

- Follow the Camp ECHO “Camper Code of Conduct” guidelines
- Wear a face mask at all times when social distancing can’t be maintained - this safety practice is recommended per Governor Pritzker
- Adhere to Coronavirus guidelines regarding social distancing
- Be responsible for personal belongings at all times to lessen the spread of germs
- Be able to independently participate and engage in scheduled activities for the duration of the day while maintaining social distancing
- Be able to independently wash their hands without assistance
- Be in a reduced camper to staff ratio while being able to participate and transition from activities independently to lessen the spread of germs
