Important Reminders

- Camp ECHO will send out reminders and updates regarding weather, pick up locations, etc. throughout the summer via the Rainout Line system.

Physical Behavior

Physical violence at Camp ECHO will not be tolerated. Any act of physical violence, to include but not limited to, kicking/punch/hitting/biting/hurting another child or staff is subject to an automatic dismissal from the remainder of the day. Physical incidents will be tracked for the duration of the summer and handle in the manner below:

- 1st Incident – Camper will be sent home for the remainder of the day.
- 2nd Incident – Camper will be sent home for the remainder of the day and suspended for the next day. This will include first day of next week if occurrence is on a Friday.
- 3rd Incident – Camper will suspended for the remainder of the week AND their next registered week.
- 4th Incident – Camper will be removed from camp for the remainder of the summer.

Refunds will NOT be issued for a camper suspended for any amount of time.
