Location:

The Cary Park District's Dog Park is located at Hoffman Park on West Main Street. From Route 14 head south on Cary-Algonquin Road to West Main Street. Then, turn west on West Main Street. Follow West Main Street until it ends at the parking lot access point.

Dog Park Features:

- 18 - acre fenced in dog park that includes a mowed grassy open play area, a field meadow, and a tall grass area with walking trails.
- A fenced-in small dog area.
- Two training areas for owners to acclimate dogs that are off-leash for the first time.
- Agility course.
- Amenities include dog waste bag stations, garbage/recycling cans, and a drinking fountain for both dogs and people.
- Restrooms available.
- Double gate entry with electronic key access for security and valid dog pass users only.

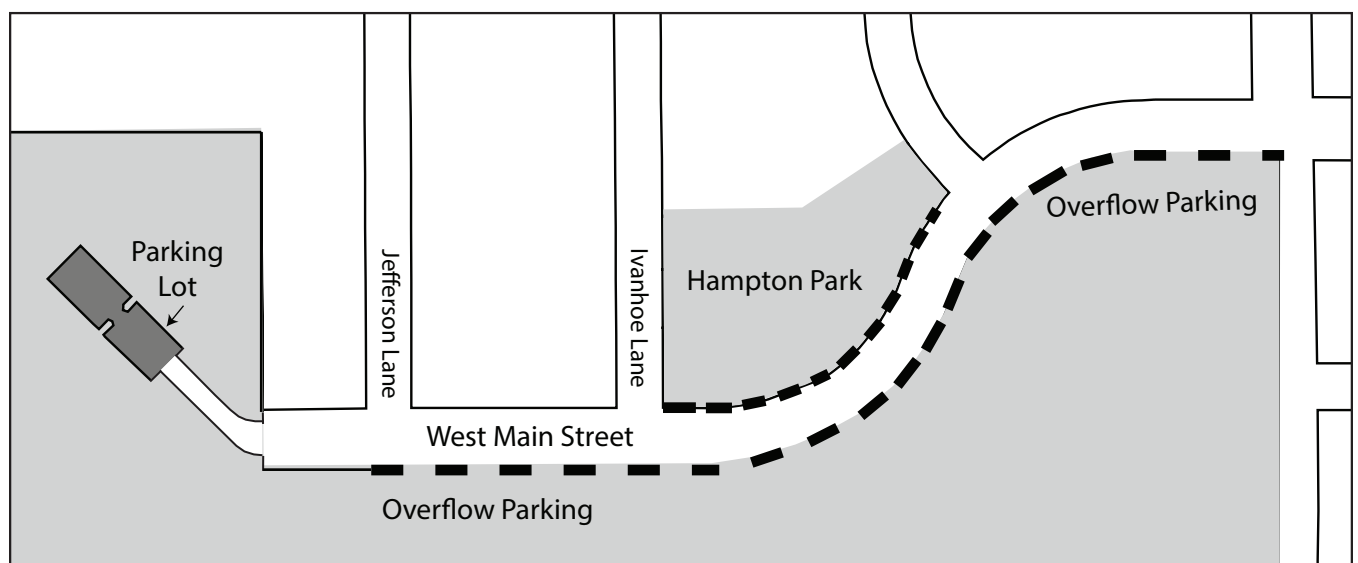
Vaccinations:

Copy of current vaccinations required at the time of registration and renewal. Each registered dog must have a completed Veterinarian Verification Form on file.

Parking:

Parking is available in the lot at Hoffman Park. Overflow parking (---) is available on the south side of West Main Street from Jefferson Lane to Georgetown Drive or adjacent to Hampton Park. There should be NO dog park parking on Jefferson and Ivanhoe Lanes.



Renewal Notices:

Renewal notices will be sent by e-mail approximately one month before your pass is to expire.

Dog Park User Fees (annual fee):

The annual fee provides you with access to the dog park for one year from the date of purchase. Passes can be purchased at the Cary Park District Community Center, 255 Briargate Road. Passes are required for entrance to the dog park. Proof of residency is required to receive the resident rate, (driver's license, house purchase contract or apartment lease, current utility bill, or real estate tax bill). Passes are not transferrable.

A minimum of 48 hours may be required before electronic keys are issued.

Discounts or reduced pricing is not available for partial year use of the dog park. Daily passes are not offered by the Park District.

Guidelines For Use:

1. Users of the facility do so at their own risk. The Cary Park District is not responsible for any injury or damage caused by any dog in or outside of the off leash area.
2. The dog park is open from dawn to dusk.
3. The following activities or items are prohibited within the confines of the dog park: food of any kind, dog treats, littering, bikes, and climbing on or over the fence.
4. Cooperation between dog owners is expected, including keeping order and enforcing dog park rules and Park District ordinances.
5. Collars are to be securely fastened and worn at all times. No pincher or spiked collars allowed.
6. Dogs must display the current Park District ID and a county rabies tag on their collar.
7. A dog handler 18 or older must be present at all times and is solely responsible for the action of their dog(s) and any guests accompanying them.
8. Maximum number of dogs per adult is two and both dogs must remain in the same exercise area as their owner. Large dogs (26 pounds and up) are not allowed in the small dog area.
9. Dogs must remain in sight of the owner and should never be left in the park unattended.
10. Dogs must be leashed prior to entering and leaving the park. Owners must carry a leash for each dog at all times.
11. Dogs running free in the park should remain away from the gates when other dogs are entering and exiting.
12. No aggressive dogs allowed. Immediately leash your dog and exit the park if aggressive behavior is displayed.
13. Patrons should not chase dogs in the park.
14. Before approaching or handling another dog, obtain permission from the owner.
15. Dogs that are in heat, under 6 months of age, or bark excessively are not permitted in the park.
16. No electronic devices, firearms, explosive devices, noise makers, and live or dead animals may be utilized for training purposes or any other purpose within the dog park.
17. Patrons are responsible to clean-up and dispose of feces left by their dog. Failure to pick-up after your dog may result in a fine up to \$500.00 and loss of park privileges.
18. Patrons are responsible to fill any holes their dog may dig.
19. Failure to comply with the rules may result in loss of privileges and removal from the park.
20. Cary Park District staff has the authority to close the site for maintenance, weather hazards, rule violations, and special events without prior notice.
21. In case of emergency (dog bite or dangerous behavior) immediately call 911 for assistance. All other issues please call the Cary Park District at 847-639-6100.

Liability Waiver

You are solely responsible for supervising your dog(s) and determining whether or not this is an appropriate activity in which to participate. You must understand that you are participating in this activity at your own risk (and risk of your dog(s)). You are solely responsible for determining if you and/or your dog(s) are physically (or temperamentally) fit and/or adequately skilled to use the dog park. It is always advisable, especially if you or your dog(s) is pregnant, disabled in any way or recently suffered an illness, injury or impairment, to consult a physician or veterinarian before using the dog park.

Warning of Risk

Dog activities are intended to provide a fun and rewarding experience for a dog(s) and its owner. However, despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury, including death to either the dog(s) or its owner. Dogs are pack animals and when "off leash", even the best-trained dogs will act instinctively. Understandably, not all hazards and dangers associated with dog activities can be foreseen. Certain inherent risks include the propensity of any dog to behave in dangerous ways that may result in injury to another patron or dog(s). Other risks include, but are not limited to the inexperience, negligence or irresponsibility of a dog owner; the inability to predict a dog's reaction to sound, movements, objects, persons, or other animals; and actions by the dog(s) due to fright, anger, stress, insect bites, or natural reactions such as jumping, pulling, resisting and biting. Other risks include the hazards associated with environmental and traffic conditions, acts of God, inclement weather, slipping, falling, premises defects, failure in instruction and or supervision, and all other circumstances inherent to dog and outdoor activities. Should you attempt to break up a fight between dogs, you may be attacked and severely mauled by the other dog(s) or even attacked by the other patron. In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for the Cary Park District to guarantee absolute safety.

Waiver and Release of All Claims and Indemnification Agreement

Please read this form carefully and be aware that in consideration for permission to use this facility, you will be expressly assuming the risk and legal liability and WAIVING and RELEASING all claims for injuries, damages or loss which you or your dog(s) might sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with and associated with presence upon and use of the dog park. I recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injury to the dog(s) and its owner in association with participating in dog activities, and I voluntarily agree to abide by all applicable rules and assume the full risk of any injuries, damages or loss, regardless of severity, that I might sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with or associated with use of the dog park. I do hereby agree to waive, relinquish, release and forever discharge the Cary Park District including its officials, agents, volunteers and employees from any and all claims for injuries, damages or loss that I may have or which may accrue to me and arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with the use of this facility or surrounding area. I further agree to INDEMNIFY and hold harmless and defend the Cary Park District from and against any and all losses, injuries, claims, damages, liabilities, cause of actions, and expenses (including attorney fees), on account of personal injuries or death to any person or dog(s), or damages to property occurring, growing out of, incident to, or resulting directly or indirectly from my and my dog's use of this facility or surrounding area. I have read and fully understand the above important information, warning of risk, assumption of risk and waiver and release of all claims.
